Under Oath he stated that he was legitimately born in "Chastock, Summersett" and lived with his parents in Chastock till he was 11 years old when he was bound as a Parish apprentice to Richard **WYATT** of Chastock, Farmer, that he lived with Richard Wyatt his Master for about 2 years when his Master turned him away, then he hired himself as a Servant with John **WILLS** of Chastock Farmer at the rate of 5d per day, with whom he worked 2 months; then he hired himself as a Servant with Thomas **DRYDON [DRAYTON?]** of Chastock, Farmer with whom he worked a quarter of a year, and that about a fortnight since he had come into the Parish of Stoke Damerell where he had been wandering up and down and begging. He hath not done any act to gain a Settlement in any Parish or place whatsoever otherwise than in Chastock. Signed with his Mark.
