

# MEMORIAL INSCRIPTIONS AT ST ANDREW'S CHURCH CHARDSTOCK

## INTRODUCTION

The original list of memorial inscriptions in St Andrew's churchyard was carried out by Joan Tunstall and Mary Parmiter in 1971 - 1972. This was updated by Peter Wood and Roger Carter in 2000.

The Chardstock Historical Record Group completed a further update in 2007, and included the inscriptions in the Church and on the War Memorial (about 75 metres to the east, on the road towards Tytherleigh). Plans of the Church and the churchyard, showing the position of the memorials, have been added. Note that the numbering system has been changed since the earlier surveys. A list of memorials in the Church and churchyard, given in *The Book of the Axe* (published 1875), is also included.

Following a crosscheck against the Parish Registers, it appears that a few of the old dates, which are now illegible, were transcribed incorrectly. These have been noted.

- 50 ANNING. Sarah died 9 June 1886 aged 40.
- 51 MILLER. Joseph died 25 Sept 1898 aged 44, also Bessie died 23 Aug 1920 aged 33, also Jane wife of Joseph died 1 May 1928 aged 74.
- 52 POWELL. Elizabeth Burden of Cadland died 21 June 1865 aged 47.
- 53 MILLER. Jane died 5 Apr 188? also her husband William died 15 May 1892 aged 82.
- 54 LARCOMBE. William died 30 Sept 1870 aged 48 also Eliza Larcombe his wife died 10 Nov 1896 aged 76, also John their son died 31 Dec 1871 aged 25.
- 55 DARK. Sarah Ann died 6 May 1900 aged 77.
- 56 SMITH. William son of John and Frances Smith died 11 Aug 1870 aged 20. *Almost illegible in 2007*
- 57 MASON. Joan died 15 Apr 1964. In memory of my dear wife. *This memorial has been replaced with one reading: William Joseph Mason died 25 Sept 1978 aged 81, also his wife Joan died 15 April 1964 aged 67*
- 58 SPILLER. William Henry of Lodge husband of Sarah Glyde Spiller died 15 May 1901 aged 44, also Annie Elizabeth Spiller, daughter, died 4 Mar 1914, also Sarah Glyde Lugg died 18 Jan 1938 aged 78.
- 59 WILKINS. Robert at Salisbury on Whit Sunday 1876 aged 27, also Robert Wilkins his father died 3 Dec 1886 aged 76, also Sarah Wilkins his wife died at Bristol 3 Dec 1888 aged 63.
- 60 ZEALLEY. Arthur died 30 Nov 1925 aged 76, also Suzanna (died) 6 Nov 1901 aged 47.
- 61 LONG. Ann died 16 Dec 1888 aged 73, also Amelia Compton her sister died 6 Feb 1896 aged 83.
- 62 HUCKETT. Norman Geoffrey died 15 Apr 1983 aged 48.

- 69 SMITH. Isaac Lisle died 20 Sept 1943 aged 72, also Maria Jane his wife died 31 May 1946 aged 77.
- 70 SMITH. James died 21 May 1918 aged 81, also Laetilia his wife died 23 June 1908 aged 64, *also, on a separate inscription, Laetilia May Hull daughter of George and Mabel Hull died 5 Mar 1910 aged 7.*

- 71 SMITH. William James died 10 Oct 1907 aged 41.
- 72 HULL. George W died 30 Dec 1943 aged 64, also Florence Mabel his wife died 7 Apr 1966 aged 89.
- 73 BOWRING. Robert died 26 Nov 1833 aged 62, also Jane his wife died 30 Dec 1826 aged 53 *This is now difficult to decipher [2007]; the Pulman list gives Jane's year of death as 1820, but the Parish Registers show a Jane Bowering being buried on 3 Jan 1827.*
- 74 *No apparent inscription. Possibly Daniel Brownsell - see separate list of missing inscriptions*
- 75 PEARCE. Madeline Louisa died 1 Oct 1932 aged 69, also John her husband died 8 Nov 1934 aged 63, also Fred their son died of wounds in France 6 June 1917 aged 21 and Alice their daughter died 11 Dec 1902 aged 7.

- 77 *Against the church tower. It is not clear whether this is a grave slab*
- 78 DEANE. Richard died at Alston 23 June 1891 aged 87, also his wife Mary Anne died 14 Apr 1887 aged 77.
- 79 DEANE. Isaac died Chilson Chard 1878 aged 75, also William Deane died Axminster 18 Oct 1891 aged 84. *This memorial was illegible in 2000.*
- 80 SEARLE. William H died 4 Dec 1930 aged 72 and his wife Elizabeth died 28 Sept 1938 aged 74.
- 81 SEARLE. Ernest J 1902 - 1987 and Peter.
- 82 HULL. Robert died 21 Feb 1913 aged 72 and Ann died 7 Mar 1925 aged 80.
- 83 North Side.  
DEANE. Isaac of Wambrook son of Robert and Sarah Deane died 27 June 1831 aged (?), also Robert Deane son of aforesaid John who died - 44 years also Elizabeth wife of said John died 18th - 73 years. Also - wife of aforesaid Johnomase -
- East Side.  
Sarah daughter of John and Elizabeth Deane of South Chard who died 1803 aged 4 years, also the above John Deane son of the aforesaid Robert and Sarah who died 6 Apr 1806 aged 49, also Thomas Deane of Tatworth son of Robert and Sarah died 1810 aged 41, also Robert son of Robert and Sarah died 1821 aged 49 (?).

- 87 WALE. John died 5 Feb 1935 aged 86, also his brother William died 15 Feb 1935 aged 85.

- 88 WALE. Sarah died 30 July 1881 aged 64, also William Wale her husband died 8 Oct 1885 aged 70, also Robert Wale grandson of above died 8 Oct 1894 aged 6 months.
- 89 TIDY. Bernard Thomas Walter 1898-1964. *This memorial has been replaced by another which reads Peter Tidy 1898-1964 and his wife Beatrice 1907-1996.*
- 90 DEANE. John of Ridge died 14 Aug 1897 aged 76, also Mary Maria sister of above died 8 Jan 1901 aged 77.
- 91 BISHOP. Annie Maria died 6 Sept 1926 aged 77.
- 92 *This has clearly been illegible for many years*

- 94 ELMERS. Alice Maud died 31 Dec 1914, also Hyacinth Mabel (Baby) wife of F.R.Arscott died 31 Aug 1938, also Gladys Lilian Featherstonehaugh wife of Major A.J.S Featherstonehaugh D.S.O. died 27 Dec 1934.
- 95 WOODCOCK. Gambier Digby son of Edward E. Woodcock and Mary his wife died 15 October 1858 aged 18.
- 96 To the memory of a dead father by his three surviving children M.H.B. MDCCCLVII
- 97 H.S.W. July 1867. *This appears to mark the grave of Honora Sarah Woodcock, who was buried on 3 August 1867 aged 57*
- 98 Sibyl aged 15 months 1868. *This appears to mark the grave of Sibyl Machonochie, who was buried on 10 June 1868 aged 15 months.*
- 99 WOODCOCK. Frances Parry died 8 Oct 1909 and Rosa Grace Woodcock died 17 July 1910 and Anna Harriot Woodcock died 22 Feb 1913.
- 100 BRAGGE. John died 1815 aged 77, also son John died 1793 aged 7.
- 101 STONE. Edwin Charles died 25 Dec 1925 aged 83. *This memorial was moved to its present position between 1972 and 2000. From its place on the original list it appears that it was originally in the South West corner of the churchyard.*
- 102a WALE. Jane died 18 Feb 1866 aged 43.
- 102b WALE. Joseph born 3 July 1820 died 17 June 1894, also Maria wife of the above died 31 Aug 1919.
- 102c WALE. Robert died 30 May 1890 aged 71. For 40 years he managed with fidelity and diligence the Manor of Chardstock for Lord Henley by whom this monument is erected in grateful acknowledgement of his long and valuable service
- 102d WALE. Susan Mary died 22 Jan 1956.
- 103 SMITH. Catherine died 22 Mar 1873 aged 90 after 60 years service with Dr. Sutherland and Rev. Woodcock.
- 104 LERESCHE. Louise Emily Georgette (Swiss) died 20 Aug 1872 aged 61 after 30 years service with Rev. Woodcock.
- 105 JEFFERY. William died 30 Jan 1915 aged 77, also Charlotte Drake wife of the above died 9 Mar 1929 aged 90 and daughter Helena 1950 aged 75.
- 106 ROBINSON. Ann widow of Henry Robinson of Beverley Yorkshire and Patras Greece died 2 July 1878 aged 71.

- 107 BINDON. Simeon died 26 Feb 1932 aged 80, also Eliza his wife died 15 Dec 1914 aged 72.
- 108 STRAWBRIDGE. Albert John died 29 June 1947 aged 62, also Emily his wife died 3 Feb 1959 aged 74.
- 109 STRAWBRIDGE. Elizabeth died 4 Dec 1936 aged 81, also John Strawbridge husband of the above died 17 Sept 1946 aged 87.
- 110 *No apparent inscription*
- 111 STRAWBRIDGE. Monica Emilie eldest child of Albert and Emilie died 29 Aug 1918 aged 9.
- 112 MASSENHOVE. Paula, infant daughter of Henri Josal Van Massenhove of Ostend aged 5 months. A victim of the Great War. *A small stone cross which is now dis-interred and leaning against the hedge.*
- 113 SPILLER. Elizabeth died 12 Sept 1891 aged 33.
- 114 CHUBB. George died 4 Sept 1885, also Eli Chubb died 10 July 1889 aged 34.
- 115 LONG. Ann Mary 1893 - 1974.
- 116 LONG. Frederick Daniel died 8 Mar 1917 aged 64, also his wife Annie Compton died 9 Aug 1956 aged 85 and their son Frederick William died 20 Sept 1918 aged 26.
- 117 *No apparent inscription.*
- 118 HUNT. Emily died 20 Jan 1958 aged 87.
- 119 ADAMS. William Josias died 14 May 1957 aged 79, also Bessie Mary his wife died 20 Aug 1986 aged 92.
- 120 PARSONS. Ann wife of Benjamin died 16 Apr 1892 aged 35, also Hannah Rose Hockey their only daughter wife of Frank Hockey died 3 June 1936 aged 49.
- 121 SEWARD. John G. husband of Jessie died Alston Farm 5 Jan 1932 aged 60, also Jessie A. Seward died 17 Sept 1952 aged 82.
- 122 ROBERTS. John died at Featherlake 22 Sept 1921 aged 76, also Henrietta his wife died Reeds Hill Chardstock 23 July 1911 aged 61.
- 123 PARSONS. William George died 26 Mar 1959 aged 62.
- 124 LARCOMBE. Abraham died 20 Apr 1905 aged 54, also Susan his wife died 19 Mar 1925 aged 70.
- 125 LARCOMBE. Mary died 8 Sept 1876 aged 52, also John Larcombe her husband died 18 Jan 1877 aged 59 and Susan mother of John died 31 Mar 1871 aged 78.
- 126 LARCOMBE. Eli husband of Selina died 25 Dec 1922 aged 64.
- 127 ROBERTS. John died at Wadbrook 8 Oct 1935 aged 70, also Alice M. Roberts died 20 Dec 1944 aged 82 and Mary Howard died 11 Oct 1951, also Eve Roberts sister of the above died 19 Dec 1960.
- 128 ROBERTS. Robert Herbert son of Thomas and Elizabeth of Wadbrook died 3 Jan 1900 aged 28.
- 129 ROBERTS. Thomas of Wadbrook Farm died 28 Jan 1913 aged 80, also Elizabeth his wife died 20 May 1934 aged 99.

- 130 ROBERTS. Timon died at Overdale Tytherleigh 15 May 1952 aged 87, also Maggie Eva Roberts died 11 May 1960 aged 72. (*This memorial fallen down in 2000*).
- 131 *The original metal plaque bearing the inscription is missing in 2007. Possibly John Beer - see the separate list of missing inscriptions*
- 132 BONFIELD. Lousia died 17 Sept 1918 aged 48, also Emma Bonfield died 4 Mar 1921, also Henry her husband died 17 Aug 1927.
- 133 SEWARD. Frederick died 28 May 1953, also Louise his wife died 14 Dec 1956 and Flossie their daughter died 30 Nov 1920 aged 23.

*Memorials 134 - 139 were moved to their present position in the late 1980s; they had previously been leaning against the church wall. Their original locations are not recorded. Numbers 136 and 137 have some discernable writing on them, but are now illegible. Possibly these are the memorials of Thomas Estmond and John Hoare - see the separate list of missing inscriptions.*

- 138 LONG. Gainey died 23 July 1935 aged 91 and George Long died 23 Feb 1915 aged 76. Erected by their four eldest children.
- 140 *No memorial stone. Believed to be the grave of John/Jack Spiller, father of Louise Seward née Spiller - see 133 above.*

- 142 COX. Harriett wife of William Cox died 19 Nov 1931 aged 65.
- 143 SEALY. Colonel Humfrey Newnham 1887 - 1947.
- 144a PILTON. Annie Elizabeth wife of William Henry Pilton died 2 May 1955 aged 75. Also William Henry Pilton died 20 Aug 1972 aged 89.
- 144b PILTON. William John, son of Henry and Elizabeth, 7 Jan 2000 aged 85.
- 145 COWING. Sidney George died 15 Sept 1950 aged 64.
- 146a PILTON. Charles Leslie son of Henry and Elizabeth died 1 Aug 1937 aged 20.
- 146b LARCOMBE. Dorothy Gladys wife of Ernest E. Larcombe died 18 Dec 1945 aged 32.
- 147 COUSINS. Sarah died 3 Dec 1941 aged 79, also her husband Samuel interred in Chard cemetery.
- 148 LATTER. Maurice Plevins geologist & 2nd Lt. R. A. born 1899, killed on active service 4 Dec 1940. Also Margaret Constance, 17 Nov 1897 - 3 July 1988.
- 149 PERRYMAN. John died 31 Dec 1890 aged 65, also Eliza his wife died 31 Aug 1902 aged 74.
- 150 SLOMAN. Richard died 8 July 1912 aged 69 and Emma Sloman died 22 Mar 1918 aged 72. "In loving memory of our dear Father & Mother".
- 151 GRABHAM. Mary died 26 July 1932 aged 79, also John husband of the above died 18 May 1938 aged 85, also Tom their son died 26 Dec 1940 aged 51.
- 152 GRABHAM. Albert George died 6 Apr 1928 aged 60 and Eliza his wife died 19 Apr 1936 aged 72.
- 153 GRABHAM. John died 6 Sept 1899 aged 95, also his wife Jane Selina Grabham died 15 Apr 1904 aged 80.

- 154 BENTLEY. Abraham of Wooton Farm died 30 Apr 1882 aged 75, also George Abraham Bentley died Cogans Farm Thorncombe 22 Feb 1927 aged 66, also Catherine Sarah his wife died Cogans Farm 1 Dec 1900 aged 30.
- 155 HEMPHILL. Alex Hemphill of Kenya May 1896 - October 1961. *Also a plaque* : Alex Hemphill of Kenya May 1896 - October 1961, also his wife Marjory October 1896 - May 1989. *This memorial is on what should be the grave space for memorial 154*
- 156 SLOMAN. Francis died 26 Apr 1889 aged 80. *In its present position in 2000; the sequence of the 1972 list suggests that this memorial was originally between memorials 152 and 153.*
- 157 SLOMAN. Maria died 29 Aug 1897 aged 90. *See note on 156 above.*

- 163 SEWARD. Sarah Ann died at Axminster 1 Nov 1923 aged 80 and Sarah Seward her mother and Luke her father who were laid to rest in this churchyard.
- 164 VERIOD. William son of James and Joan (*mostly illegible in 1972; completely illegible in 2000.*)
- 165a HULL. In memory of our parents Sydney Hull died 15 Aug 1925 aged 52 and Sarah Annie Hull died 21 Apr 1956 aged 80, also of their sons Frank Sydney Hull, killed in action in France 25 Apr 1917 aged 20 and Arthur and George Hull who died in infancy.
- 165b LARCOMBE Ada Kate died 4 Nov 1923 aged 80
- 165c HULL Cyril Ernest died 26 Nov 1983 aged 72.


