

PARISH OF WAMBROOK**1861 CENSUS****RG9/1635**

The census was carried out on the night of 7th April 1861 and closely followed the format of the previous census taken in 1851. The head of the family had to be defined as did the relationship to the head of each person staying in the house that night. The sex of each person was also recorded. Accurate ages were required throughout and were taken from the person's last birthday. For infants under one year, the age was recorded in months (indicated in the transcript by the use of m for month e.g. under 1m, 5m, etc.). The rank, profession or occupation of each person was recorded and there were extensive guidelines printed on the form advising people how to complete this section. There was a separate column to record any persons who were deaf-and-dumb or blind.

An analysis of the recordings for Wambrook are tabled below:

Not included in the above summary is a family of 13 travellers living in a caravan parked in the parish on the night of the census.

The census recorded 143 males (52.6% of total) and 129 females (47.4%)

There were 49 occupied dwellings, which produced an average of 5.6 persons per dwelling, and 1 uninhabited dwelling.

A full analysis of the censuses for 1841 to 1911 appears as part of the introduction to the 1911 census.

The transcript was made by members of CHRG from copies of the original documents. When extracting information from this transcript, the following points should be noted:

* In 1861 Wambrook formed part of the County of Dorset, as the transfer to Somerset did not occur until 1896.

* The overall standard of this return is better than the previous one in 1851, but there are still cases where the return would seem to have been incorrectly completed. "Notes" have been added to correct any obvious errors.

* Shortening of forenames has been avoided wherever possible with full names being given in the transcription. Also, full stops have not been used in names, thus Wm. C. Larcombe in the census return would appear as William C Larcombe. By the same logic the town or Parish of birth is given in full, whenever possible.

* In the transcription the column headed "Mar" uses the abbreviations M for Married, U for Unmarried and W for Widow or Widower.

* To save space and achieve consistency, the place of birth is given first, followed by the county, indicated by the use of the "Chapman County Code" system. The codes used in this Census are listed below:
