

PARISH OF WAMBROOK**1891 CENSUS****RG12/1892**

The census was carried out on the night of 5th April 1891 and followed the format of the previous censuses taken since 1871. The head of the family still had to be defined as did the relationship to the head of each person staying in the house that night. The gender of each person was also recorded. Accurate ages were required throughout and were taken from the person's last birthday. For infants under one year, the age was recorded either in months (m), weeks (Ee) or days (d). The rank, profession or occupation of each person was recorded and "Where Born" had to be completed by giving the county and town or parish of birth. The expanded list of infirmities introduced in 1871 was retained, but was sometimes used to record medical conditions not included in the official list.

The 1891 census varied from those taken previously in three ways - the Occupational Status of each person in employment had to be categorised using three options - Employer (Ee), Employee (Ee) or Neither (N), Single (code S) replaced Unmarried (U) and the number of rooms occupied by each household had to be recorded if less than five.

An analysis of the recordings for Wambrook are tabled below:

The census recorded 122 males (52.8% of total) and 109 females (47.2%)

There were 48 occupied dwellings, which produced an average of 4.8 persons per dwelling, and 5 uninhabited dwellings.

A full analysis of the censuses for 1841 to 1911 appears as part of the introduction to the 1911 census.

The transcript was made by members of CHRG from copies of the original documents. When extracting information from this transcript, the following points should be noted:

- * In 1891 Wambrook formed part of the County of Dorset, as the transfer to Somerset did not occur until 1896.
- * The overall standard of this return is better than the previous one in 1881, but there are still cases where the return would seem to have been incorrectly completed. "Notes" have been added to correct any obvious errors.
- * Shortening of forenames has been avoided wherever possible with full names being given in the transcription. Also, full stops have not been used in names, thus Wm. C. Larcombe in the census return would appear as William C Larcombe. By the same logic the town or Parish of birth is given in full, whenever possible.
- * In the transcription the column headed "Mar" uses the abbreviations M for Married, S for Single/Unmarried and W for Widow or Widower.
- * To save space and achieve consistency, the place of birth is given first, followed by the county, indicated by the use of the "Chapman County Code" system. The codes used in this Census are listed below:
